

Perfecto Mundo® Evergreen Azaleas (*Rhododendron spp.*) Double Pink 'NCRX3' USPP32819 Double Purple 'NCRX4' USPP33205 Double White 'NCRX5' USPP33900 Double Dark Pink 'NCRX7' USPP33923 Orange 'NCRX6' USPP33945 Epic Coral 'NCRX10' USPP35049 Red 'NCRX8' USPP33922 Epic Pink 'NCRX9' USPP35072 Pink Carpet 'NCRX11' USPP35082 Fuschia Carpet 'NCRX12' PPAF Reblooming azaleas with a variety of flower colors, forms and sizes. Cold-hardy with compact forms.

Brilliant Barberries (*Berberis* spp.) Sunjoy Neo® 'NCBT2' USPP33272P2 Sunjoy® Orange Pillar 'NCBT3' USPP30330 Neon orange foliage in compact and upright forms. Maintains cheerful bright orange foliage all season. Rust resistant.

Non-Invasive Barberries (*Berberis* spp.) Sunjoy Todo® 'NCBX1' USPP29504 Sunjoy Mini Maroon® 'NCBT1' USPP30330 Compact selections with dark purple or purple-red foliage. Field trials confirm nearly 99% reduction in female fertility over multiple years.

Pearl Glam<sup>®</sup> Beautyberry *Callicarpa* 'NCCX2' USPP28312

A striking, compact beautyberry with dark foliage and hot pink/purple fruit.

Unique intergeneric hybrid with large, orchid like, purple flowers on long racemes. Summer flowering shrub or small tree.

#### Cloudburst<sup>™</sup> Flowering Dogwood Cornus 'NCCH3' PPAF

A new disease-resistant flowering dogwood with exceptionally large flowers, clean foliage, and vigorous growth.

Yuki Cherry Blossom® 'NCDX1' USPP25916 Pink flowers with a low, ground-cover habit. Yuki Snowflake® 'NCDX2' USPP28347 White flowers and a low, ground-cover habit. Yuki Kabuki<sup>™</sup> 'NCDX3' PPAF Small shrub with large, panicles of showy pink flowers.

## Star Flower Shrubs (*Illicium* spp.)

Non-invasive *Ligustrum japonicum* with glossy foliage

'Mercury™ Magnolia
Magnolia 'NCMX1' USPP29218
Deep pink buds open to large, fragrant lavender flowers.
Blooms up to a month later than traditional *M. soulangeana*, greatly reducing flower loss to frost. Deciduous.

### Mahonia (*Mahonia spp.*) Good Vibes 'NCMH1' USPP34442. Yellow flowers. Groovy Glow 'NCMH2' USPP34443. Multi-colored flowers. Compact with dense branching; soft, refined dark evergreen foliage with long racemes of showy flowers in spring.

## Pink Cascade<sup>™</sup> Flowering Cherry

**Prunus** 'NCPH1' USPP27579 A dramatic weeper with bright pink flowers.

#### **Pyracomeles**

Juke Box<sup>®</sup> ×*Pyracomeles* 'NCXP1' USPP31409. Thornless. Berry Box<sup>™</sup> ×*Pyracomeles* 'NCXP2' PPAF. Red fruit. An intergeneric hybrid between *Pyracantha* and *Osteomeles*. Compact habits with evergreen foliage and white flowers. A durable Boxwood alternative.















## Flowering Pears (Pyrus spp.)

**Javelin® Pear** 'NCPX1' USPP26539 Fastigiate pear with purple new growth in the spring. Fire blight resistant.

#### Chastity® Pear 'NCPX2' USPP30788

A non-invasive, triploid flowering pear with dark green flossy foliage, orange/red fall color and profuse white flowers in spring. Fireblight resistant.

#### Dandyman Color Wheel<sup>TM</sup> Rhododendron

*Rhododendron* 'NCRX1' USPP31150 Landscae ptough, disease resistant, evergreen rhododendron with frilly, color-changing red-to-white flowers. Thrives in the heat of the SE US.

### 'Schima Lina Ding Dong' Mountain Schimlinia *xSchimlinia*

A novel intergeneric hybrid between *Schima remotiserrata* and *Franklinia alatamaha*. Fragrant white flowers in late summer. Broadleaf evergreen.

Candy Corn® 'NCSX1' USPP28313 Multi-tone foliage transitioning from bright orange red to chartreuse gold with magenta flowers. Seedless. Doozie® 'NCSX2' USPP30953P3

A revolutionary *Spiraea*: dense, continuous bloomer with dark red flowers and new growth; seedless.

#### Steady Eddy® Doublefile Viburnum Viburnum plicatum var. tomentosum

\*NCVP1' USPP33899 Compact, floriferous, reblooming viburnum with showy white flowers.
